**1. APOLOGIES.**

**2. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS.**

**3. TO NOTE THE MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE HELD ON 7 JANUARY AND PREVIOUSLY SIGNED AT FULL COUNCIL ON THE 26 JANUARY 2014.**

The minutes were noted.

**4. TO DISCUSS AND AGREE A RESPONSE TO THE PLANNING APPLICATIONS.**

**a. HCC/2015/0127 – Fryern Infant School, Oakmount Road, Chandler's Ford Hampshire SO53 2LN Installation of a double temporary modular classroom and additional playground.**

Members looked at the plans of the proposal and received a briefing from the Clerk noting the reasons given in the application for the temporary classrooms. The response as proposed, seconded and agreed was that there was NO OBJECTION but a hope was expressed that a permanent solution be found in the shorter term

**b. F/15/76293 Asda Supermarket, Bournemouth Road, Chandler's Ford Construction of a storage building and erection of a canopy within the existing rear service area following removal of existing structures.**

Members discussed the plans and agreed that the proposals were out of sight at the back of the carpark. It was noted that the site was untidy at present and that the proposals should improve that. It was also noted that it was part of the home delivery operations and could have benefits in local jobs. Following proposal, seconding and a show of hands the agreed response was NO OBJECTION.

**5. TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM CLLR BULL ON THE ACCESS ISSUES FROM THE CENTRAL CLUB AND THE NETWORK RAIL MEETING**

Cllr Bull reported on his meeting that it transpired that the bridge was not a Network Rail property rather Hampshire County Council. It was agreed the Clerk would contact the local highways officer, copying-in County Councillor Davidovitz, and progress the matter. Members discussed the options they felt might resolve the line of sight and resulting safety issues. They also mentioned the HGV deliveries to other properties.
