Public Participation: There were no members of the public present.

1. APOLOGIES.

There were received from Cllrs Aubry and Dolbear.

2. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS.

None were received

3. TO NOTE THE MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE'S MEETING OF 5 NOVEMBER ALREADY AGREED AT THE FULL COUNCIL MEETING OF 17 DECEMBER 2018.

These were noted.

4. MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION HAVING RECEIVED RESPONSES TO PREVIOUS QUESTIONS ASKED: -

a. to discuss and agree how to proceed with the provision of additional bench seating on the verges of residential roads within the parish.

The Chairman commented that a map had been received from EBC and that thought needed to be given to suitable locations. The existence of a dilapidated bench on Hursley Road was noted and suggestions were made about positioning a bench halfway up Scantabout as well as potentially in Carthage Close. A Member commented about the issues that had been created with additional dual use rubbish/dog bins in North Millers Dale and that consultation would be the key. It was also suggested that they shouldn't be under lights as it could encourage ASB. Members were asked to give the Clerk their thoughts.

b. to discuss and agree how/if to proceed having gained further information on insurance for verge planting.

The Chairman commented that he had received an indicative cost for insurance through his brokers at £280.44 per annum to provide £1M of cover. A motion was tabled to refer the matter to P&F that they accept the insurance quote and that CFPC takes out insurance for verge planting across Chandler's Ford. It was clarified that at that point it would be an agreement 'in principle'. Following proposal seconding and on a show of hands this was AGREED. Further discussion then took place on how a scheme might be rolled out using trial areas.

5. TO AGREE MATTERS TO BE TAKEN TO THE NEXT AGENDA OF THE COMMITTEE

Feedback from P&F over the verge planting and potential bench locations.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.45pm. The next meeting was scheduled for 1 July 2019.
