4. MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION.

Planning application F/19/85629. 103 Bournemouth Road Chandlers Ford
The Chairman commented that the latest revision to the site plan, 7519_D01 had changed the
original proposal of 10 no 1 bed flats and 2 no 2 bd flats with 13 associated parking spaces, to 5 no
1 bed flats and 5 no 2 bed flats with 11 associated parking spaces.

Members felt that whilst the proposal for more small flats in Chandlers Ford was to be welcomed, the location would severely compromise the local parking capabilities.

Therefore, members requested the Assistant Clerk send a response to the case officer at Eastleigh Borough Council stating that whilst the Parish Council is sympathetic to the application, the revised proposals are not acceptable. Should the developer be minded to revert to the original application, including parking, in accordance with the Residential Parking Standards adopted by EBC, members would support the development.

Following proposal and seconding and on show of hands, the response was unanimously AGREED
